Introduction

Warning

This manual describes the basic safety rules to be observed during any operation carried out with the EDO cardboard bricks. The operating and cleaning procedures of EDO bricks, described in the following chapters must be carried out respecting both the manner of performance indicated and the general safety standards. Different countries may have different hazard regulations. It should be noted, therefore, that in all cases in which the rules of the manuals are in conflict or reductive compared to the standards of the nation in which the game is sold and used, the rules of the nation will have priority value on those of the manuals.

- **WARNING:** This product may only be used by a child under adult supervision. An adult must be present when the game is played.
- **WARNING:** There is danger of choking if the packaging of the bricks and its plastic wrapping are swallowed or put into child's mouth or if it is not cut properly. Keep the cardboard packaging and plastic bags for packaging EDO bricks out of the reach of children. Dispose of them in compliance with the regulations on disposal .
- **WARNING:** There is danger of ingestion if the bricks are bent or improperly cut by the child and put in the mouth, resulting in a choking hazard. Adult supervision when the child is playing is essential.
- Check the integrity of the product when delivered. If you find any damage, failure, deformation or traces of shock due to transport, report it to PLAYEDO before proceeding with the following operations.
- EDO is a toy intended for children aged between 3 and 14 years.
- Do not leave EDO bricks near heat sources.
- Do not use or place EDO bricks near an open flame
- Store EDO bricks in a closed box in a clean, dry place, away from heat and adverse weather conditions before and at the end of their use.
- Keep the packaging and the EDO bricks from coming into contact with sharp edges and abrasive surfaces.
- **DISPOSAL:** The product is subject to separate collection at the end of its life cycle. Do not for any reason dispose of this product as unsorted waste. Refer to local regulations regarding the disposal of waste cardboard.

Game Description



Edo bricks are delivered in flat cardboard sheets and are very easy to assemble. Following the instructions in the section "How to Use", children aged 10 and up can have fun doing it by themselves but younger ones will need the help of an adult. This activity can be transformed into a beautiful moment of sharing and connection.

WARNING: Any recreational activity with EDO bricks should always be under the supervision of an adult

Edo bricks are made of high quality micro-corrugated cardboard. Their characteristics have been chosen to provide a perfect balance between weight and strength: a single brick, used properly, can support up to 50 pounds.

For the sake of the environment, the cardboard is recycled, 100% recyclable and FSC certified: greener than that! Cardboard and bricks are categorically Made in Italy.

The Montessori method

The 'go it alone', learning by doing and sharing of the game are the basics of the Montessori Method. With Edo bricks, children can invent and play with their ideas. Creating something new that did not exist before stimulates their imagination and creativity. The size of the blocks allow children to build 'life size' buildings, developing a sense of space and socializing. Edo is fun to play alone, but creative thinking becomes contagious in large and small groups.

Cleaning and storage

Gently wipe the outer parts of the product to remove dust and dirt with a dry cloth.

CAUTION:

- Do not use a wet cloth.
- Do not use detergents and / or mild soap.
- Do not use solvents, abrasive or corrosive cleaners.

When not in use, place the items on a box, away from direct sunlight, heat, dust, liquids and moisture.

In this instruction manual, the residual risks were taken into account and an explanation has been provided to avoid them.

- When the package is delivered make sure that there is no trace of impact, abrasion and / or dirt, mold, etc. that may have been caused during transport and / or bad storage. If this happens, report it to the communications manufacturer (**see data Manufacturer**).
- Before giving it to a child to play with, an adult has to ensure that the contents are undamaged. Should there prove damage, dangerous surfaces and sharp edges, it is strictly forbidden to give the game to the child.
- The game is not suitable and cannot be used by children under the age of 36 months. This is also indicated on the product label.



- If the child is allowed to remove the cardboard packaging and plastic wrapping, it must always be under adult supervision. The supervisor will then proceed to immediately dispose of the packaging and never allow the child to play with it.
- Disposal of the plastic and cardboard packages must be in compliance with local regulations and standards.
- To ensure that the toy does not become dirty and bacteria liable, it is necessary to clean it regularly. **See Cleaning and Storage in this manual**
- Before you let the child play with the game to check for cleanliness.

Disposal

The plastic wrapping around the box must be discarded in special plastic rubbish bins (yellow), according to the regulations. The cardboard box should be discarded in special rubbish bins (blue) according to the regulations.

The bricks must be disposed of in the cardboard waste bins if they can no longer be used for the purpose for which they were designed and constructed, thus making re-use of the raw materials that constitute them possible.

Do not discard the plastic wrapping or the actual game into the environment.
